

## LETTER OF AUTHORITY FOR ATA CARNET APPLICATION OR USER

An ATA Carnet may be used in the name of an individual or a company who must be permanently resident in the United Kingdom. However, it may be used by any person providing the user carries a letter from the named holder authorising such use (see example below).

The holder may also allow an Agent to handle the ATA Carnet through the customs on his behalf, again provided that the Agent holds a Letter of Authority.

Box B (name of accredited person(s) who will use the ATA Carnet) on the green front cover and the coloured vouchers would then contain the statement: "Any Authorised Representative"
